ITEM NO. 3 TO CONSIDER THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE UNIVERSITY FOR THE PERIOD 2023-24

Prof. Dr. Saad Ahmed Qazi, Dean, Faculty of Electrical & Computer Engineering (ECE) presented this item through multimedia presentation which was further elaborated by the Vice Chancellor in detail for consideration of the Senate under section 14(b) of the NED University Act. - (e) The Budget Estimates for Research Fund for the financial year 2024-2025 amounting to Rs 151.486 million and Final Demand (Second Revised Estimates) for the financial year 2023-2024 amounting to Rs 207.348 million as recommended by the Syndicate vide its Resolution No. SYN-209.7(a)(v) dated 28-05-2024 (details as appended in working papers of Volume-II).
